An over anxious committee chairman submitted Mr. Santorelli's registration prior to doing some checking. After his appearance at several troop meetings and a committee meeting, there was considerable concern expressed by parents and committee over his desirability as a leader. Subsequently, Mr. Santorelli was asked by the committee not to return and he has in fact, dropped out of sight.

For the record, the troop committee based its request on the following information it was able to gather. Mr. Santorelli worked at a local resort, Lake Cohonk. He evidently took two sons, of a guest, on an unauthorized evening walk, down by a lake. When the resort was questioned by the father about the experience, Mr. Santorelli was dismissed. He had held a couple of different jobs in New Paltz, N.Y. since then, but is no longer involved in scouting and currently can't be located.

My guess is that the man in the questionnaire is the same person we had, but uncertunately we cannot provide any further details,
