You may have seen recent media reports related to allegations of sexual misconduct by the late Dr. Reginald Archibald while he was employed at Rockefeller University. Many decades ago, Dr. Archibald was affiliated with our organization as a board member and as a volunteer at our former clubhouse on East 29th Street, which closed in 1999. Dr. Archibald died in 2007.

We are deeply disturbed by these allegations and are taking this matter very seriously. The Board of Trustees has retained Nancy Kestenbaum of Covington & Burling LLP to conduct an independent investigation into Dr. Archibald's conduct at, and past association with, Madison. Ms. Kestenbaum is a former federal prosecutor who has extensive experience investigating reports of sexual misconduct.

Nothing is more important to Madison than the safety and well-being of the children we serve. We have strict policies and procedures in place to make sure our club members are safe at all times and that our staff is trained to identify and report any signs of abuse.

As part of the independent investigation, which is ongoing, Ms. Kestenbaum has established several confidential ways for former club members or other individuals to share information about Dr. Archibald.
